### CADET NOTES

- April SCHEDULE.** There are 4 drills in April. Our main focus is on preparing for the Flagship competition to include and uniform inspection on 22 March. If you are going away for spring break and will miss a drill please let your chain of command know as soon as possible. You must pass your PRT as soon as possible if you failed or have not completed.
- FLAGSHIP COMPETITION.** We will be leaving for Flagship competition on Friday 26 April with a muster time of 1200 (noon). Please make arrangements with your schools as you will need to leave early. Absence letters will be provided. This event will

require a full sea bag to include dress blue/winter dress uniform. The cost of the event is \$65.00. Please make checks out to DEALEY DIVISION NSCC. Detailed information will be provided separately.

3. **TRAINING.** Summer training is here. Check USNSCC [Homeport](#) regularly to see what's available. Cadets should carefully consider what training is required for advancement. Try and attend more than one training if possible.

### **STANDING NOTES**

1. **ADVANCEMENT.** Focus on completing requirements for advancement which include correspondence courses, exams and PRT.
2. **PHYSICAL FITNESS.** Always bring your PT gear if you need one as it is required to advance and to attend training. The PRT consists of a 1-mile run, push-ups, and sit-ups (1 min).
3. **ATTENDANCE.** Attendance will be regularly reviewed. Regulations state that you should attend 75% of all scheduled drills. **If you cannot attend, you shall notify your chain of command.** Failure to attend could result in the discharge from the program. We will plan make-up drills as necessary but please make every effort to attend regularly.
4. **CORRESPONDENCE COURSES.** You are required to complete at least one course per year. All assignments can be found on the Sea Cadet [homeport](#). All cadets are required to turn in at least one (1) coursework assignment per month until complete. Cadets who have completed Recruit Training will not advance to SA until completing the Basic Military Requirements (BMR) course.
5. **INCREASE YOUR KNOWLEDGE.** Find out everything you wanted to know about the U. S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps on the NSCC Online Portal: <http://homeport.seacadets.org/secure/Home.aspx>.
6. **ENROLLMENT FEES.** The cost of (re)enrollment for 2019 is still \$90.00 for all cadets for now. Payment is due to receive your new ID card.
7. **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT RIBBON.** Do not forget to bring in a copy of your report cards for Division Officer Review and awarding of the Academic Achievement Ribbon. The award of this ribbon has been extended to NLCC Cadets as well.

### **STAFF NOTES**

1. All staff members, are encouraged to attend Officer Professional Development (OPD) courses and complete the [Officer Midshipman Study Guide](#) (OMSG). The OMSG is required for all Instructors. OPD and OMSG is required for all Officers. See the training officer for access.
